NEW ENGLAND SUPERCHARGER NEWS (08-07-22) - John Harris

Tesla continues to expand its Supercharger charging network at an incredible pace.

Saturday July 23rd, 2022, a blistering near-100-degree morning, our club held an opening welcome event for the Hanover, MA supercharger. We had over fifteen cars brave the heat and Cape-bound traffic to join us for chat and refreshments courtesy of the local Chic-fil-A and our own Bev Jones.



The Burlington, MA supercharger opened on Thursday 7/28, eight long months after initial groundbreaking last November. We are excited to host a grand opening meet-up there on Saturday August 13th from 9am-11am (see above).

Construction News. The Tyngsborough, MA superchargers are (still) nearly done, awaiting utility hookup. Word is they could be open any day now. The Gloucester, MA supercharger construction appears to be complete a bit faster than expected. With the transformer now on site we hope to see it open very soon. Tesla's new prefabricated supercharger construction technique is being used in East Templeton, MA. Ground breaking occurred the last few days of July, and site completion possible by the first half of August. For our northern members the West Lebanon, NH expansion is nearly done, adding 8 new v3 stalls to increase capacity and cover peak holiday demand along the I-89 corridor. What we thought would be a short v2-only site disruption turned into a multi week shutdown to accommodate significant trenching, rewiring and transformer replacement. The good news is it's nearly done and should be up soon. Also under construction are St Johnsbury, VT and Waterville, ME.

Future Directions. Many new locations have recently been permitted, clearing the way for new supercharger construction in the months ahead! Without a doubt the biggest permit found this past month was for Danvers, MA. It's site plan includes a reference to both v3 and an alternative option that, although not named, is likely new v4 supercharger technology. This discovery took the Tesla social media world by storm within hours of being posted to Twitter as it was the first site plan found that includes a reference to the next generation superchargers. This one will be closely watched for sure. In central MA the Sturbridge and Palmer permits were found, adding more charging options along the Mass Turnpike. The Neon Marketplace convenience store chain continues its rapid expansion, with a Quincy, MA store already under construction with future superchargers planned, and two additional locations in various stages of permitting presumably with supercharging in western MA that we hope to be able to share soon. The Common Man Roadside has Epsom and Portsmouth NH in permitting that both include supercharger installation in their future. The Common Man Roadside currently operates the I-93 Hookset NB/SB locations already.
